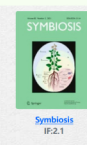

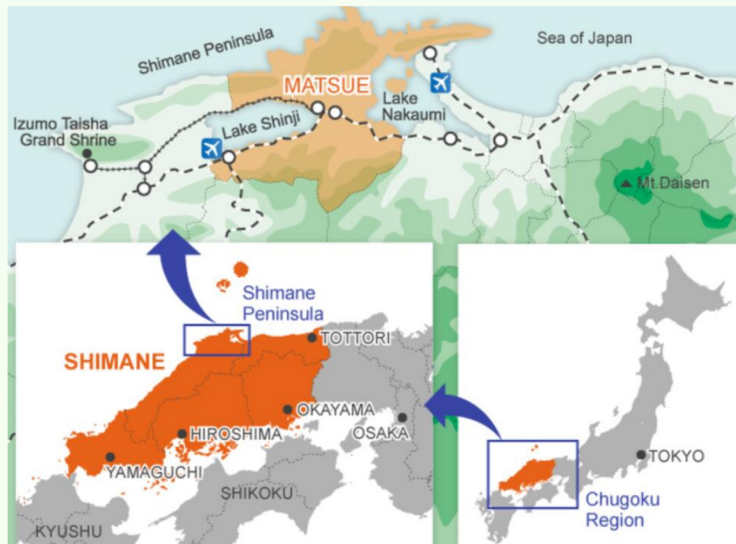

About Matsue

ABS 2025 will be held in Matsue. Matsue is the capital city of Shimane Prefecture, in Southwest Japan, known as the "City of Water". It is a true castle town crossed with many canals. Matsue and its surrounding areas are rich in cultural assets and historical sites, and many of Japan's most ancient legends are set in the area. As an International City of Culture and Tourism, Matsue offers great sightseeing opportunities and welcomes international tourists with significant discounts.



Banquet Site and Tour Spots

Matsue Castle

Constructed in 1611 by Horio Yoshiharu, Matsue Castle has become the city's symbol. It is the only remaining castle in the San'in region, one of the only 12 remaining castles nationwide, and designated as a National Treasure in 2015.



Horikawa Sightseeing Boat

This 50 min sightseeing boat guides you along the moats through the historical Japanese scape of the castle Matsue, the places related to Lafcadio Hearn, forests.



Yushien Garden (由志園, Yūshien)

Yushien Garden a large garden most celebrated for its peony flowers since 1975, and it features traditional landscape garden elements, including a central pond, waterfalls, streams, stone lanterns, a rock garden and a variety of seasonal flowers.
